During February we will begin the season of **LENT** where we observe the journey, passion and resurrection of Jesus Christ. "Lent is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which **begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday**. Lent comes from the Anglo-Saxon word *Lenten*, which means 'spring.' The season is a preparation for celebrating Easter. Historically, Lent began as a period of fasting and preparation for baptism by converts and then became a time for penance by all Christians. The First Sunday describes Jesus' temptation by Satan; and the Sixth Sunday (Passion/Palm Sunday), Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem and his subsequent passion and death. Because Sundays are always little Easters, the penitential spirit of Lent should be tempered with joyful expectation of the Resurrection." (UM Book of Worship, p.320)

This year "**Ash Wednesday**" is on February 22nd and "**Easter**" is April 8th.

As is our custom, we will host a **Lenten Luncheon** every Wednesday at **12:00 noon in the Fellowship Hall**. These will begin the week following Ash Wednesday on **February 29th** and will conclude on **March 28th**. Each luncheon will feature a guest speaker and all are welcomed to attend. A schedule of the luncheon dates and persons speaking will soon be available.



A CALL TO FAST DURING LENT

(Fridays – Sunrise to Sunset)

During this Lenten season, I want to invite you to **fast from solid food on Fridays from "sunrise to sunset"** (breaking the fast with the evening meal). This will begin on February 24th and conclude on Good Friday (observance of Jesus' death) April 6th. In this way, Fridays can become a time of prayer and meditation as we humble ourselves and pray for the sick among us, for those in need, and for the needs of our country and world. Remember, *if we fast without prayer then we are only starving ourselves*. If unable to fast, or you do not wish to fast, please join us in being in prayer together during the Fridays of Lent.

As we begin and move through the season of Lent, we do so mindful that our desire is to grow closer in our walk with the Lord. *Without the Lord we are nothing, but with God – all things are possible!*

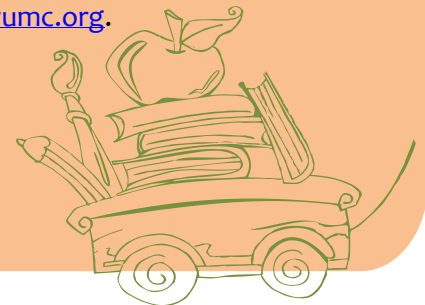
